Net Neutrality Wins: TRAI Prohibits Discriminatory Tariffs for Data Services.

On Net Neutrality, an article has been published in ILA Newsletter (volume no. 31, issue No. 9, September, 2015) titled: **Net-Neutrality: The Voice of Libraries** in which the views of library and information professionals have been raised. The objective of raising the voice was to sustain the freedom of Internet. In the same line of action, communication from ILA was submitted to Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), Government of India. We realized that this decision is in the interest of the society at large. It is not only the victory of LIS professionals but also the victory of information consumers.

TRAI has issued regulation namely “Prohibition of Discriminatory Tariffs for Data Services Regulations, 2016” on February 8, 2016 and saved the rights of the internet users. In its order, TRAI has exercised its powers conferred upon it under sub-section (1) of section 36, read with sub-clause (i) of clause (b) of sub-section (1) and sub-section (2) of section 11, of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India Act, 1997 (24 of 1997) and stated the following

(1) No service provider shall offer or charge discriminatory tariffs for data services on the basis of content.

(2) No service provider shall enter into any arrangement, agreement or contract, by whatever name called, with any person, natural or legal, that has the effect of discriminatory tariffs for data services being offered or charged to the consumer on the basis of content: *Provided* that this regulation shall not apply to tariffs for data services over closed electronic communications networks, unless such tariffs are offered or charged by the service provider for the purpose of evading the prohibition in this regulation.

(3) The decision of the Authority as to whether a service provider is in contravention of this regulation shall be final and binding.

TRAI has reviewed the international scenario that while certain jurisdictions such as the United States and the European Union have adopted variations of the case- by-case approach, several others such as the Netherlands and Chile have barred differential pricing outright. A study of the international experience is no doubt useful in formulating an informed strategy. However, each country has devised its own suitable regulatory strategy on the subject. A suitable regulatory framework for India therefore, must necessarily be based on our country-specific factors, the need to equitably increase internet usage and penetration, foster competition, allow start-ups to flourish and uphold the law of the land, the substantive arguments regarding which have been dealt with above

Taking into account responses in the consultation, relevant international experience, expert opinion, research studies and all other inputs, the Authority has concluded that a clear rule should be formulated-the practice of offering or charging discriminatory tariffs for data services based on content, is to be prohibited. Therefore, TSPs are prohibited from offering different tariffs based on the content, service, application or other data that a user is accessing or transmitting on the internet. Tariff for data services cannot vary on the basis of the website/application/platform/or type of content being accessed. For example, a: consumer cannot be charged differently based on whether she is browsing social media site A or B or on whether she is watching streaming videos or shopping on the internet. Keeping in View India's large number of internet users and content producers, both of which are rising exponentially, the TRAI has taken a view that prohibition of discriminatory tariff for data services is necessary to ensure that service providers continue to fulfill their obligations in keeping the internet open and non-discriminatory.

Launch of MedPix®: a free online medical image database

The National Library of Medicine is pleased to announce the launch of MedPix®, a free online medical image database originally developed by the Departments of Radiology and Biomedical Informatics at the Uniformed Services University, Bethesda, Maryland, USA. The URL is <https://medpix.nlm.nih.gov/>.

The foundation for MedPix was a radiology study tool that was originally developed by Dr. J.G. Smirniotopoulos in 1984. In the early 1990s, as radiology was moving from film to digital imaging, there was simultaneously a merger of the diagnostic imaging residency programs of the two premier military hospitals: Walter Reed Army Medical Center and the National Naval Medical Center. In the summer of 1999, a Web-based digital teaching file based on the radiology study tool was built at USUHS to allow the two military training programs to share teaching file cases— https://www.nlm.nih.gov/research/visible/visible_human.html — a training requirement. Soon, other military hospitals and several civilian institutions joined MedPix. Over the past 16 years, MedPix has amassed an impressive collection of over 53,000 images from over 13,000 cases.

The MedPix collection categorizes and classifies the image and patient data for each of several subsets of image database applications (e.g. radiology, pathology, ophthalmology, etc.). The content material is both high-quality and high-yield and includes both common and rare conditions. Most cases have a proven diagnosis (pathology, clinical follow-up). The teaching file cases are peer-reviewed by an Editorial Panel. Continuing Medical Education (CME) and Nurse Education (CNE) were added to the MedPix system in 2001.

As a public education service, the NLM and MedPix provide the storage service, indexing, and Web server hosting. Individuals as well as institutions may participate. Contributed content may be copyrighted by the original author/contributor. No additional software required—your Internet browser is all you need!

The primary target audience includes resident and practicing physicians, medical students, nurses and graduate nursing students and other post-graduate trainees. The material is organized by disease category, disease location (organ system), and by patient profiles.

Dr. Carla Hayden appointed as 14th Librarian of Library of Congress.



Mr. Barack Obama, President, USA appointed Dr. Carla Hayden as 14th Librarian, Library of Congress and on this occasion he said that Michelle and I have known Carla since her days working at the Chicago Public Library, and her dedication to learning and education is unparalleled. More recently, she's been hard at work revitalizing Baltimore's struggling library system as the CEO of Enoch Pratt Free Library. Last year, during the unrest in Baltimore, She kept the doors of the Pratt open as a beacon for the community.

Dr. Hayden held a handful of academic and library appointments in Pittsburgh and Chicago, where she began her career in 1973 and rose to chief librarian. Before appointment to Library of Congress, she was the member of the National Museum and Library Services Board and National Foundation on the Arts and the Humanities since 2010. Her understanding of the pivotal role that emerging technologies play in libraries will be essential in leading the Library of Congress as it continues to modernize its infrastructure and promote open access and full participation in today's digital world. Finally, Dr. Hayden is the first woman and the first African-American to hold this position in its 214 year history – both of which are long overdue.

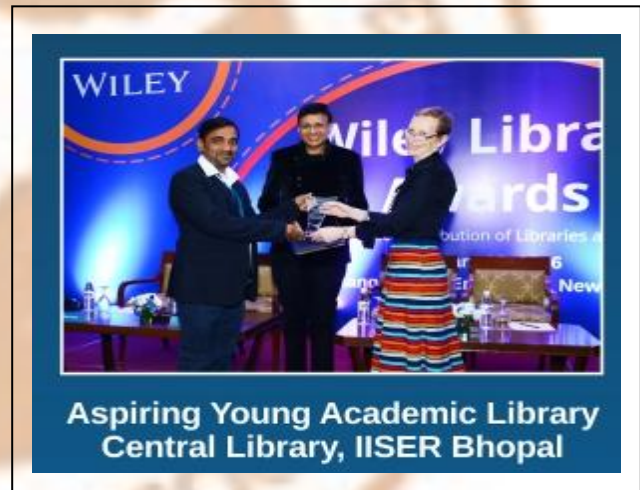

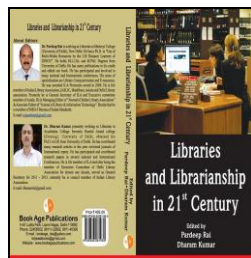

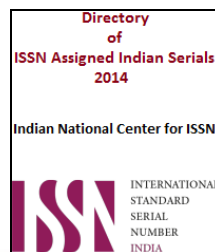

Past Events Net Neutrality vs Free Basics



Mysore University Information and Library Science Alumni Network (MILAN) in association with SDM Institute for Management Development (SDMIMD) organized panel discussion on "Net Neutrality vs Free Basics" on Monday, February 1, 2016 at SDMIMD Mysuru. During the panel discussion, N.V. Sathyanarayana (Satya), Chairman & Managing Director, Informatics India Ltd., has expressed his views that 'Internet is not something which can be owned by someone. As such, the facility should be free, with no discrimination Dr. Shalini R.

Urs, Executive Director, International School of Information Management (ISiM), University of Mysore, Mysuru, justified the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India's (TRAI) decision to reject Free Basics, pointed out that the initiative would give undue advantage to certain Internet Service Providers at the cost of others. She said accepting or negating the net neutrality is not very straight forward issue. Mr. Kalpesh Mehta, Founder, Starsoft-India, Mysuru, said that the limited accessibility of Internet through Free Basics gives Facebook control over what its consumer should access. Further, he said Facebook is misleading users by using the word 'Free' and thereby trying to become a controlling Speaking on the non-adherence to the ideology of Net Neutrality, Dr. Sudhir Sosale, Director, Centre for Training in Advanced Technologies, National Institute of Engineering (NIE), Mysuru said that there is a possibility of Free Basics be misused. As an example he said what happens if Free Basics allows information pertaining only to a political party on priority basis during elections. He said there is only 30 per cent of Indian population on Internet; such discrimination approach would give a huge and undue advantage to a chosen few at the cost of others. Experts said that TRAI should protect the rights of netizens in using Internet and realize the true agenda The Panel discussion was moderated by Prof. Malathi Sriram, SDMIMD. Prof. N.R. Parasauraman, the Director of SDMIMD, Dr. P.Y. Rajendra Kumar, Ex DG, National Library of India and the current President of MILAN, Prof. M. Chandrashekara, Chairman of the DLISc, Dr. N.S. Harinarayana, MyDLIS and Dr. Sunil M.V., Librarian, SDMIMD and Secretary, MILAN, were also present.

Talk on Implications of Copyright in Digital Environment



Telangana Library Association jointly with Association of British Scholars, Hyderabad chapter and British Library Hyderabad has organised a lecture program at British Library on Implications of Copyright in Digital Environment on February 6, 2016.
