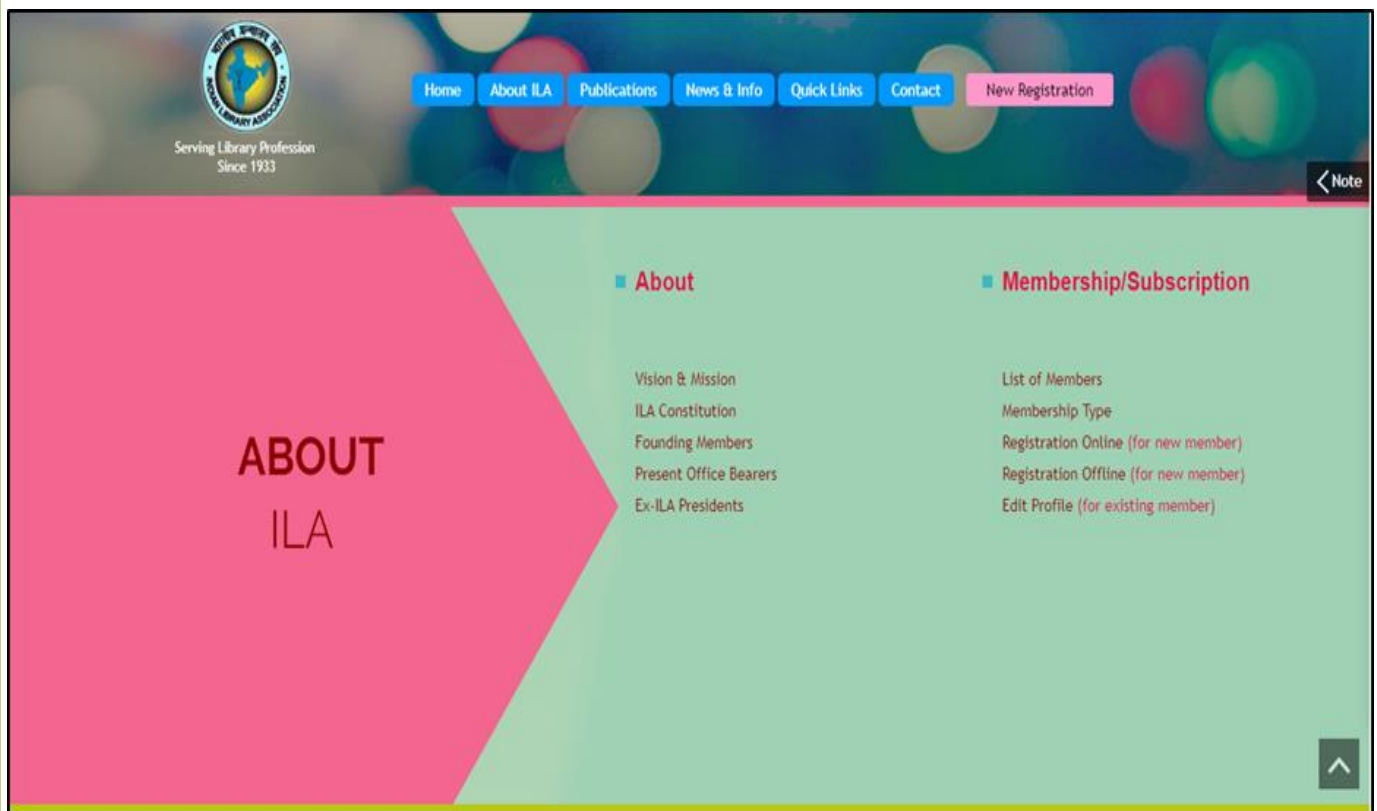

An Academic Library's mission is to lead the collaborative development of an academic institution and its informational infrastructure that enhances and meets the changing needs of:

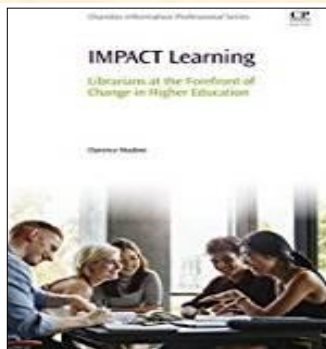
- Preservation

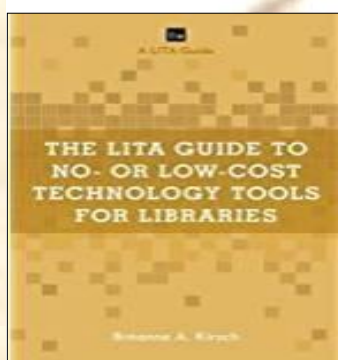
